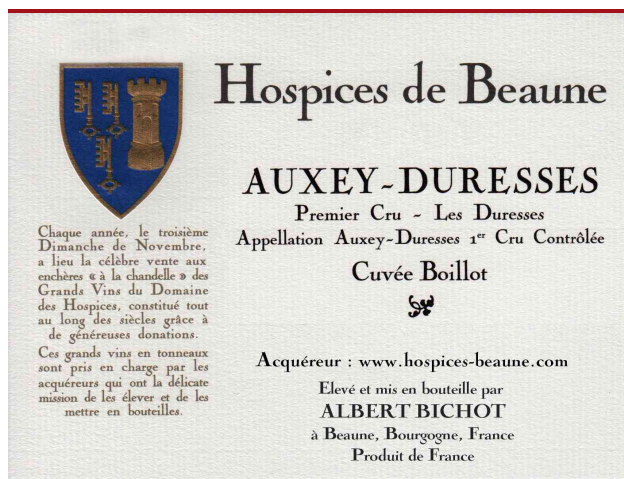


AUXEY-DURESSES 1ER CRU BOILLOT
