Rich purple colour. Floral bouquet on the nose, then a generous finely tuned fruit right across the palate, balanced by subtle tannins, almost ethereal.

HISTORY

Traditionally, this fine Cuvée of Beaune Premier Cru opens the sale. It is named for the lady nurses who have tended the sick of the Hospices since its foundation in 1443. Furthermore, several nurses left important legacies. These sisters originated from Saint-Omer, in northern France, and did their training at the Hospice of Valenciennes, which lies just within France's border today with Belgium. The wine is made entirely from Premier Cru vineyards, mainly Les Bressandes (no vines being younger than 1985), La Mignotte and Les Teurons.)
