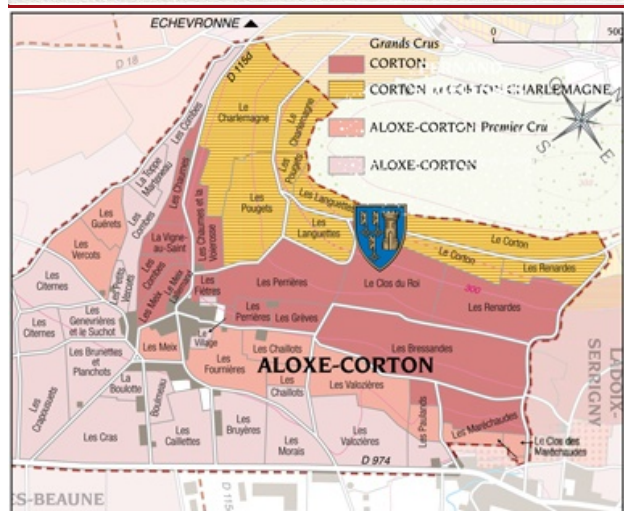
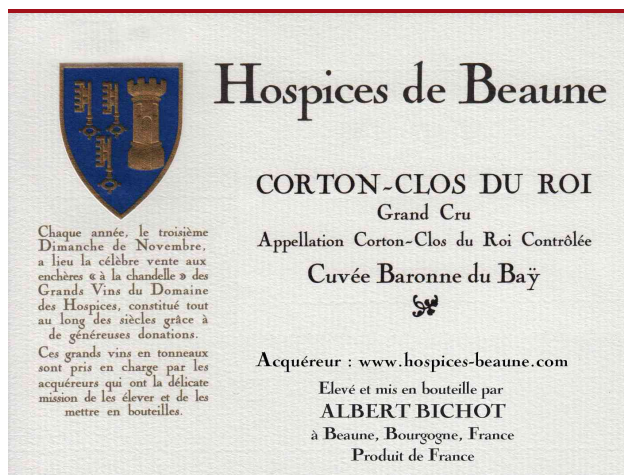


CORTON CLOS DU ROI CUVÉE BARONNE DU BAÏ

HISTORY

Baroness Du Baï was the daughter of Dr. Peste, a physician at the Hôtel-Dieu, who, during her lifetime, donated vineyards on the Aloxé-Corton hillsides, in 1924. This Cuvée has been separately vinified since 2007. It allows the unique personality of this exceptional Grand Cru terroir to be fully expressed and produces structured, distinctive and longlived wines. Over 45% of this cuvee is planted with vines aged 40 years or more, the balance being between 26 and 14 years old.
