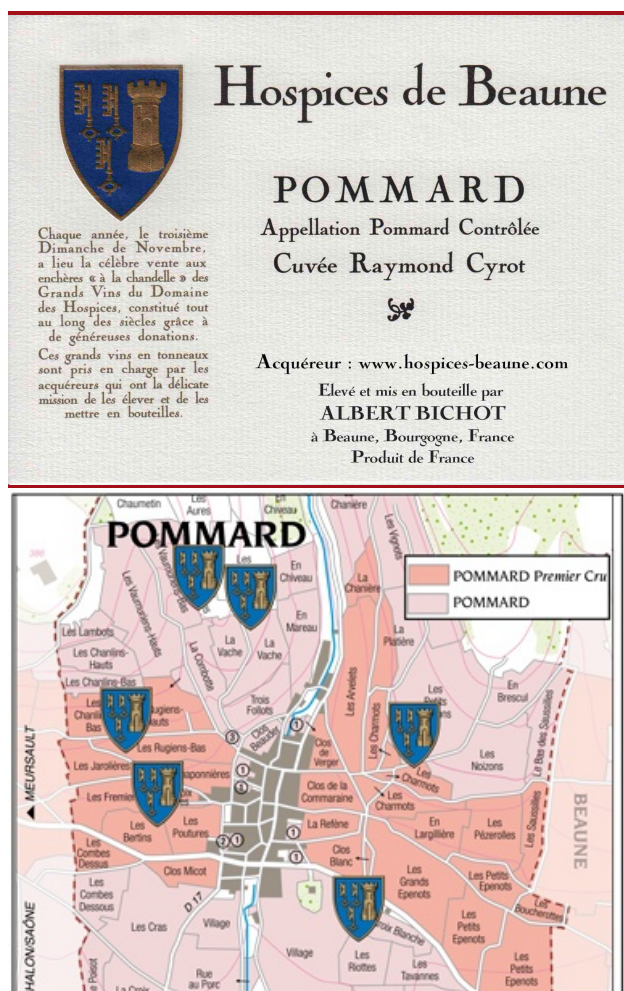


POMMARD

The gift included several plots of ancient vines, which were in perfect condition, yielding small quantities of fine fruit, and many of these have been retained. The Premiers Crus vines are situated in Les Charmots, Bertins and Rugiens bas.
