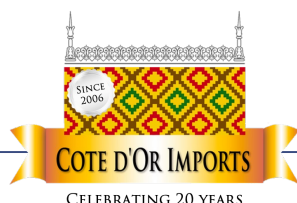

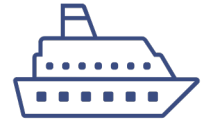

How It Works

Wines are shipped in consolidated ocean freight temperature-controlled containers, transported from our French warehouse to our US logistics platforms.

This shipping method relies on :

- Structured and regular departures
- Grouped shipments, consolidated on filmed pallets for maximum security on international leg
- Cost-effective shipping solution for non-time-sensitive shipments

Prices include final delivery via ground shipping. Our team monitors weather conditions daily and will advise if delivery conditions are not optimal.

Temperature-controlled final mile delivery is available for selected regions based on eligibility.

Timing & Cadence

Ocean freight shipments follow a defined departure schedule.

Indicative transit times range from **8 to 12 weeks**, calculated from full order validation.

An order is considered validated once all wines have been received at our French warehouse and all applicable fees have been paid.

For grouped orders, lead times depend on the receipt of all related purchases.

Delivery timelines may be adjusted due to customs clearance, carrier constraints, or exceptional weather conditions. You will be informed in the rare instance this occurs.

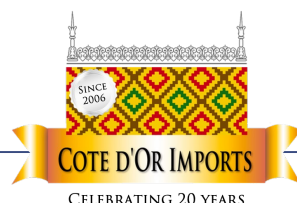

Prices include final delivery via ground shipping. Our team monitors weather conditions daily and will advise if delivery conditions are not optimal.

Timing and Cadence

Indicative delivery times range from **2 to 4 weeks**, depending on destination and operational constraints, calculated from full order validation.

An order is considered validated once all wines have been received at our French warehouse and all applicable fees have been paid.

For group orders, lead times depend on the receipt of all related purchases.

Delivery timing may be adjusted due to airline operations, customs clearance, or weather conditions. You will be informed in the rare instance this occurs.

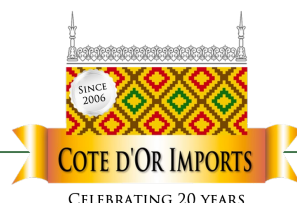

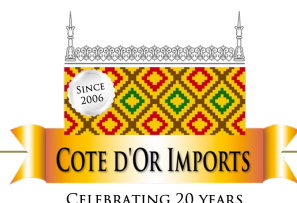

For clients seeking a more sustainable and distinctive way to ship their wines, Cote d'Or Imports offers transport via modern transatlantic cargo sailboats — combining maritime tradition with advanced technology.

How It Works

Wines are transported aboard modern cargo sailboats designed as true floating cellars, engineered specifically for the transport of fine wines and spirits.

They feature redundant temperature and humidity control systems to ensure stability throughout the Atlantic crossing.

Each section is equipped with:

- two independent refrigeration units
- cooling systems with both heating and cooling capabilities
- precise climate regulation to preserve wine integrity

Timing & Cadence

Cargo sailboat departures follow a fixed annual schedule, with **three sailings planned in 2026** (one in spring, two in autumn).

Space on board is limited. Orders are assigned to sailing based on full order validation, receipt of wines at our French warehouse and payment of all shipping fees.

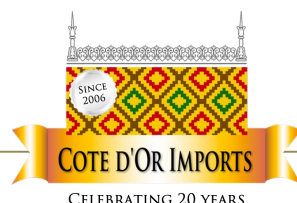
Due to this cadence, overall delivery timelines are not calculated the same as ocean or air freight shipments.

Final Delivery & Follow Up

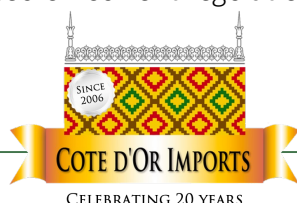

Step 3 : Preparation for Legal US import

Every bottle is inspected and prepared for legal US import. This includes repacking in export-grade materials to insure safe international transport.

Technical Shipping Details :

- A single case cannot contain bottles of different sizes.
- Shipping fees are calculated separately by bottle size and added together to determine total shipping fees.
- Partial cases (any case not containing 6 or 12 bottles) are billed at the next highest bottle count.
- Wooden cases (if ISPM-15 treated) may be shipped for an additional fee.

Step 4 : Transatlantic Transport

Your wines may arrive in the United States through one of three proven transit routes:

	Ocean Freight	Express Air	Cargo Sailboat
Timing*	8 - 12 weeks	2 – 4 weeks	3 times per year

*Delivery timing depends on order confirmation, warehouse receipt, settlement of shipping fees when applicable, and the departure of the next available freight shipping. The timing may also vary from customs clearance, international transport, delays, extreme weather or trucking availability at time of arrival.

When your wines arrive in the United States they will be delivered to our US warehouse in Oregon or directly to our delivery partners in their respective regions before final delivery based on eligibility.

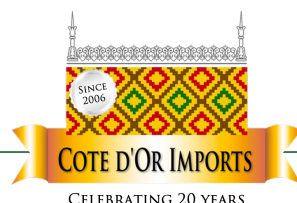
Step 5 : Last-Mile Delivery

Final delivery can be scheduled once we receive your email confirming delivery details on file.

Protecting your wines from extreme temperatures is a priority at every stage of the delivery process. When weather conditions are not suitable for immediate ground delivery, your wines are stored at no charge in our temperature-controlled Oregon warehouse until optimal delivery conditions are met.

For orders eligible for temperature-control final mile delivery, storage is not offered, as temperatures do not impact delivery conditions.

What is a Group Order ?

A group order allows multiple wine purchases from different retailers to be combined into a single shipment, delivered to one address in the United States.

This service enables you to benefit from our volume-based shipping rates while simplifying logistics and delivery coordination. All group orders are managed by Cote d'Or Imports, from France through final delivery in the United States.

When Is Grouping Useful ?

Grouping your purchases may be particularly beneficial if:

- You plan to visit several wineries or wine shops during your stay
- Your purchases are made over multiple days
- You want all wines delivered together
- Friends grouping purchases together for single delivery

The Grouping Period

A group order begins when Cote d'Or Imports is informed of your first purchase. From that point, you have **20 days** to complete additional purchases and include them in the same grouped shipment.

Once the 20-day period has elapsed, any new purchase will be treated as a separate order or may initiate a new group order.

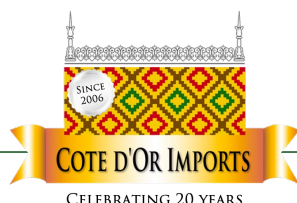
Throughout the grouping period, our team remains available to assist you, coordinate with retailers if needed, and ensure that your wines are prepared in compliance with export and US import regulations.

Grouping Your Purchases

SIMPLE STEPS, COORDINATED BY OUR TEAM

Step 1 - Purchasing Conditions

When purchasing wines for a group order, please note the following:

- Wines may be invoiced without French value added tax (TVA in French (20%)) by the retailer
- Retailers should charge wine only, excluding shipping, insurance, and processing fees*
- There is no minimum quantity per retailer
- Orders of fewer than 6 bottles or 3 magnums per retailer will be subject to an additional fee
- If a retailer has not previously worked with us and has questions, they may contact our French office directly on weekdays during business hours. Our team will ensure that conditions are clearly understood so you may purchase wines VAT-free

** If the first purchase location charges you for shipping, we will take that into account when calculating the total amount due for your group order.*

Step 2 - Pricing & Shipping Options

Our standard shipping price lists apply to group orders of up to **120 bottles**, for all shipping methods: ocean freight, express freight and sailboat cargo.

For quantities exceeding 120 bottles, a personalized shipping quote will be prepared. To do so, we require:

- your final delivery address
- the total number of bottles to be shipped
- bottle format and type

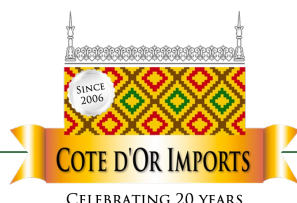
Price lists are available at many wineries and wine shops. You may wish to keep a copy with you during your travels.

Step 3 - Finalization & Billing

Once you confirm that your purchases are complete or once the 20-day grouping period has ended, Cote d'Or Imports will issue a secure online invoice in US dollars for all shipping-related fees. We cannot issue a secure invoice in euros at this time but a wire in euros is possible to our French bank account only.

If we do not receive confirmation or payment after several reminders, the order may be considered as cancelled, and the wines may be returned to the retailers after payment of our cancellation fees.

Collection of Wines in France

Cote d'Or Imports regularly collects orders from the following regions:

- Côte d'Or (Dijon to Santenay – Côte de Nuits & Côte de Beaune)
- Champagne
- Chablis
- Chalonnais & Mâconnais
- Beaujolais & Rhône
- Drôme
- Châteauneuf-du-Pape

If a retailer is located outside these regions, French domestic transport to our Burgundy warehouse must be arranged by the retailer. Any related fees are invoiced directly by the retailer and are not the responsibility of Cote d'Or Imports.

Storage Information

Storage of wines in France is not available.

Storage may be offered only in our temperature-controlled US warehouse in Oregon, free of charge, for a limited period, pending appropriate delivery conditions.

Shipping Options & Flexibility

The estimated delivery timeframe begins once:

- all wines in your group order have been received in our French warehouse
- all shipping-related fees have been paid

Lead times depend on the selected shipping method (ocean, express, sailboat).

In certain cases, it may be possible to switch from one shipping option to another if the wines have not yet departed France. Please inform our team as soon as possible should you wish to explore this option.

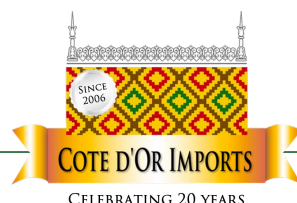
Billing Reminder

REGULATORY UPDATE

Government-mandated tariffs applicable to European imports

Following official announcements from the United States government in 2025, an import tariff of **15% on European goods**, including wine and spirits, is currently in effect.

How the tariff applies to your order

The import tariff represents **15% of the wine's declared value** and is payable at the time of settlement of shipping and insurance fees with Cote d'Or Imports, or at your point of purchase when applicable. This amount is required by US Customs and Border Protection in order for your shipment to clear customs.

No order can leave our French warehouse if the tariff has not been paid.

Customs clearance responsibility

In order for your wines to legally enter the United States, Cote d'Or Imports is required to pay the applicable tariff on your behalf at the time of customs clearance.

Once a shipment has departed our French warehouse, no changes can be made to the contents of the order. Additional purchases may, of course, be shipped separately as a new order.

There could be more tariff fluctuation in 2026. Our team remains available to answer any questions regarding the application of this tariff to your shipment and will communicate any details we have as soon as they are official.

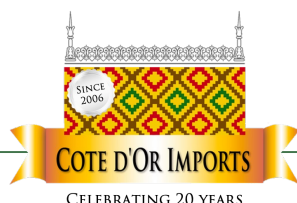
Orders already in progress

If there is an increase in tariff from the US Government in 2026 and orders are already in progress, an **additional invoice** will be issued for the balance due. This adjustment reflects the tariff amount ultimately charged by US Customs at the time of clearance.

Our commitment to fair adjustment

Should there be any reduction or cancellation of these tariffs, Cote d'Or Imports will promptly refund all or part of the tariff amount accordingly, once US Customs and Border Protection refunds Cote d'Or Imports.
