

THE HOSPICES DE NUITS-SAINT-GEORGES

8 centuries of history

Nuits-Saint-Georges' hospital dates back to 1270, two centuries before the foundation of its most famous neighbour Hospices de Beaune in 1443. The Hospices de Nuits works in exactly the same was as Beaune, combining a real medical activity and a state-of-the art wine estate.

Spread over 12,4 hectares around the town of Nuits-Saint-Georges and in vast majority planted with Pinot Noir, the Hospices de Nuits wine estate sells all of its harvest on auction and en primeur, every third sunday of march following harvest.

The following appellations are auctioned:

- Nuits-Saint-Georges (village)
- Nuits-Saint-Georges 1er Cru
- Gevrey Chambertin (village)

For each appellation, several different wines (called cuvées) are auctioned. Some cuvées are complex blends of several plots, whilst some other ones are 100% terroir-based.

Hospices de Nuits-Saint-Georges wine estate



Jean-Marc MORON is the winemaker of this outstanding estate in the heart of Côte de Nuits, covering just more than 12 ha.


He crafts every year 16 wines, mostly Nuits-Saint-Georges village and premier cru. They are all sold at an auction early March, a few months after he vinified them.

A few months after harvest, in March, the Hospices de Nuits-Saint-Georges auction is a not-to-be-missed event for all lovers of fine Burgundy wines. Each lot auctioned corresponds to a certain number of 228 litres barrels, called pièces. One barrel amounts to 288 bottles of 75 cl after ageing.

Money raised during the auction (about $M \in 2,5$) will allow the *winemaking hospital* to take care of its patients, buildings and vineyards.

As for the Hospices de Beaune auction and the most prestigious Crus Classés de Bordeaux, wines are sold en primeur, 6 months after the harvest.

After the auction held in the prestigious cellars of Château du Clos de Vougeot, the wines will be carefully aged in Albert Bichot's own cellars for 12 months. This is the time we need to bring them to their utmost potential and quality level, before being bottled and shipped to our customers in Frand and all over the world.


Albert Bichot is an independent, family-owned wine company founded in 1831. It owns 105 hectares of vineyards in Burgundy, primarily in Chablis, Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune with six exceptional domaines. Its wines, a faithful reflection of their terroir of origin, are appreciated around the world.

Since 1876, discerning customers have entrusted the buying and ageing of their Hospices wines to our company. Albert Bichot is proud to have been the top buyer at the auction for 20 years, often accounting for 20% of the total auction sales. This position gives us immense expertise in the 3 key stages of the process:

- $\ensuremath{\mathrm{1/}}$ careful selection thanks to numerous tastings between the harvest and the auction
- 2/ purchase at the right price thanks to our buying power
- $_{\rm 3}/$ 'haute couture' ageing of these exceptional wines with rigour, passion and excellence.

In addition to this acknowledged savoir-faire, Albert Bichot shares the Hospices' values of humanity and charity. On numerous occasions over the last 10 years, we have had the privilege of ageing the famous 'pièce de charité' (charity barrel) thanks to the generosity of our customers.

To make the Hospices even more accessible to wine lovers, Albert Bichot revolutionised the auction with the creation of www.hospices-beaune.com in 2009. This dedicated website enables wine lovers to participate in the Hospices de Beaune auction remotely, purchasing a single bottle or an entire barrel. It is also your gateway to enjoying some fabulous bespoke hospitality in Burgundy.







The art of ageing Hospices de Beaune wines by Albert Bichot is to bring an extra complexity to each wine AND and at the same time utterly respect its terroir of originin and the person who vinified it.



A crucial stage and expertise in bringing out the very best of these mythical wines.

The Hospices wines are always sold 'en primeur' (as futures). It is therefore essential to age them correctly for 12 to 18 months in order to coax out all their potential. Albert Bichot pays careful attention to this extremely important process, bringing its unique savoir-faire to bear.

Firstly, as a major or top buyer at the Beaune or Nuits auctions for the last 20 years, **Albert Bichot knows each terroir intimately**. Between the harvest and the auction, we will systematically **taste all wines several times** to follow their evolution and determine their potential, allowing us to provide you with our expert purchasing advice before the auction.

During the auction, Albert Bichot is able to acquire the wines at an optimal price thanks to the high number of buyers who entrust us with their orders. How? By using the **multiplication capacity**: buying several barrels in one single go, all at the same price.

We will then endow the wines with additional complexity during ageing with the selection and use of specific barrels (origin, grain, toast, age) that are perfectly tailored to the ageing of each wine. Each wine has thus a custom ageing program, perfectly tailored to its potential to reveal.

All the wines are tasted once a month and the greatest of care is applied during all the operations carried out to ensure that these wines develop their full potential (stirring of the lees, topping up the barrels with a wine of the same quality, racking, bottling, presentation in superb wooden cases).

To buy at auction through Albert Bichot is not only to entrust your purchase to the auction's top buyer, but to use the services of the only wine company to have received the International Wine Challenge's Winemaker of the Year title on 3 occasions (2004 and 2017 for its red wines, 2011 for its whites).

The Hospices wines aged by Albert Bichot have received the highest recognition. For example, the Mazis-Chambertin 2016 Cuvée Madeleine Collignon picked up the titles of best Burgundy red wine, the International Pinot Noir Trophy and the Red Champion at the International Wine Challenge 2018. In other words, it was deemed the **best red wine in the world** out of a total of 12,000 wines!



- 1. After your registration, Jean-David Camus will become your personal guide throughout the process. He will answer all your questions and advise you on the character, potential and the price to aim for for each wine.
- 2. Determine the maximum hammer price for the wines at the auction. Albert Bichot will make every effort to purchase the wines below the ceiling price agreed in the contract. Our cost is all-inclusive and there are no hidden extras: hammer price, auctioneer's fees, cost of the barrel, ageing and bottling fees and even the customisation of the label with your name as buyer. There are no middlemen between yourself and Albert Bichot!
- 3.Before the auction, you will pay a deposit of 50% of the total price. The balance will be due in the January of the following year.
- 4. Enjoy the auction with us or remotely if you cannot make it to Burgudy. The following day, we will give you the results with the final hammer price.
- 5. After the auction, we will carefully age your wine in our cellars for 9 to 12 months. During this period, you are welcome to come and taste the wine from the barrel in our cellars. This is a fantastic experience in which you will have the privilege of going behind the scenes at our Maison. You can also decide to convert your bottles into magnums or jeroboams (extra charge) and personalise the labels with your name or your company name as the buyer.
- 6. Shipment of your wines to your home address in September the year after the auction. We can also store your wines in our cellars (extra charge) for a few years should you so wish.


